## **Waterfront property offers wide views, lots of space**

The waterfront, modern minimalist house in Marion is located at the end of Converse Point — named after the founder of the rubber products company famous for its sneakers.

The deceiving façade doesn't hint at the 9,140 square feet of living space or beautifully landscaped grounds, so a pleasant surprise is found around every corner.

The house features all the visual aesthetics used by architects in the mid-20th century. The “less is more” exterior includes a flat roof with rooftop deck accessed via a spiral staircase, large expanses of windows, and simple shapes and surfaces.

“People very often use the term ‘contemporary’ to describe a house that really isn't, but this house is definitely modern design,” said Paul Grover, principal of Kinlin-Grover Real Estate in Osterville who has listed the house at \$4.995 million.
